387	Dark olive	10	gram
512	Lime	25	gram
522	Primerose	25	gram

2 Safety eyes 12mm

Crochet needle 2,5

(12 for UK and C/2 for VS)

Polyester for stuffing

Tapestry needle

Scissors

Marker

Stitches used:

MR = Magic ring

ch = chain

Slip stitch

sc = single crochet

HDC = half double crochet

DC = double crochet

incr = increase

decr = decrease

How to crochet Anna:

Body and head:

Chain 17 with Camel yarn.

1. 2 sc in the 2nd stitch from the hook, 12 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch. Continue at the bottom with 14 sc, 2 sc in the last stitch. (36)
2. 1 sc, inc, 15 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 15 sc, inc. (40)
3. 1 sc, inc, 17 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 17 sc, inc. (44)
4. (1 sc, inc) x 2 times, 15 sc, (inc, 1 sc) x 3 times, inc, 15 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc. (52)
5. inc, 1 sc, inc, 4 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 4 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 4 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 24 sc. (60)
6. 60 sc. (60)
7. (1 sc, inc) x 2 times, 6 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 6 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 6 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 25 sc. (68)

86. (3 sc, dec) x 6. (24)
87. dec x 12 times. (12)
Stuff a little bit more.



88. dec x 6 times. (6)
Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail.
Pull the thread through the 6 front loops and pull tightly. Hide the thread in the head.

Cheeks:



- Chain 9 with Bridal white yarn.
- 2 sc in the 2nd stitch from the hook, 6 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch. Continue at the bottom with 6 sc, 2 sc in the last stitch. (20)
 - (1 sc, inc) x 2 times, 3 sc, (inc, 1 sc) x 3 times, inc, 3 sc, inc, 1 sc inc. (28)
 - (1 sc, inc) x 2 times, 7 sc, (inc, 1 sc) x 3 times, inc, 7 sc, inc, 1 sc inc. (36)
 - 36 sc. (36) Stuff the cheeks.
 - 3 sc, dec x 2 times, 7 sc, dec x 2 times, 3 sc, dec x 2 times, 7 sc, dec) x 2 times. (28)
- Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Sew the muzzle on the head between round 72 and round 64. Pull the thread through the middle of the muzzle and pull tight to form 2 cheeks. Repeat this with a thread Dark olive yarn after sewing on the nose.
- Embroider the dots and the eyebrows on the muzzle, fasten off and hide the thread.

Mouth:

- Chain 6 with Camel yarn.
- 2 sc in the 2nd stitch from the hook, 3 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch. Continue at the bottom with 3 sc, 2 sc in the last stitch. (14)
 - 14 sc. (14)
 - 1 sc, dec, 2 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 2 sc, dec. (12)
 - 1 sc, dec, dec, 1 sc, dec, dec. (6)
The mouth will not be stuffed.
- Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the 6 front loops and pull tightly. Insert the thread towards round 1, so you can use it for sewing. Sew the mouth just under the cheeks.

Nose:



- Chain 5 with Dark olive yarn.
- 2 sc in the 2nd stitch from the hook, 2 sc, 2 sc in the last stitch. Continue at the bottom with 4 sc. (10)
Continue crocheting in rows instead of rounds.
 - Chain 1 to turn, dec x 2 times. (2)
 - Chain 1 to turn, dec. (1)
 - Chain 1 to turn, crochet around with single crochets. Make sure to fasten off with a sl st at the bottom center of the nose and leave a long tail.
- Sew the nose on the muzzle (see picture). Make the line of the mouth with this thread (over the thread of the cheeks). Hide the thread in the head.



Ears:

- Chain 9 with Camel yarn.
- 2 sc in the 2nd stitch from the hook, 6 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch. Continue at the bottom with 6 sc, 2 sc in the last stitch. (20)
 - 20 sc. (20)
 - 2 sc, dec, 8 sc, dec, 6 sc. (18)
 - 18 sc. (18)
 - 2 sc, dec, 7 sc, dec, 5 sc. (16)
 - 16 sc. (16)
 - 2 sc, dec, 6 sc, dec, 4 sc. (14)
 - 14 sc. (14)
 - 2 sc, dec, 5 sc, dec, 3 sc. (12)
 - 12 sc. (12)
 - dec x 6 times. (6)
The ears will not be stuffed.
- Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the 6 front loops

and pull tightly. Insert the thread inside towards round 1 to use it as sewing thread.

Sew the ears on the head between round 79 and 85. If you like, you can fold 1 ear diagonally in half and sew with a few stitches.

Belly spot:

Chain 15 with Bridal white yarn.

1. 2 sc in the 2nd stitch from the hook, 12 sc, inc. (16)
2. Chain 1 to turn, inc, 14 sc, inc. (18)
3. Chain 1 to turn, 18 sc. (18)
4. Chain 1 to turn, inc, 16 sc, inc. (20)
5. Chain 1 to turn, 20 sc. (20)
6. Chain 1 to turn, inc, 18 sc, inc. (22)
7. Chain 1 to turn, 22 sc. (22)
8. Chain 1 to turn, inc, 20 sc, inc. (24)
- 9-13. Chain 1 to turn, 24 sc. (24)
14. Chain 1 to turn, dec, 20 sc, dec. (22)
- 15-16. Chain 1 to turn, 22 sc. (22)
17. Chain 1 to turn, dec, 18 sc, dec. (20)
- 18-19. Chain 1 to turn, 20 sc. (20)
20. Chain 1 to turn, dec, 16 sc, dec. (18)
21. Chain 1 to turn, 18 sc. (18)
22. Chain 1 to turn, dec, 14 sc, dec. (16)
23. Chain 1 to turn, 16 sc. (16)
24. Chain 1 to turn, dec, 12 sc, dec. (14)
- 25-30. Chain 1 to turn, 14 sc. (14)
31. Chain 1 to turn, dec, 10 sc, dec. (12)
- 32-33. Chain 1 to turn, 12 sc. (12)
34. Chain 1 to turn, dec, 8 sc, dec. (10)
35. Chain 1 to turn, 10 sc. (10)
36. Chain 1 to turn, dec, 6 sc, dec. (8)
37. Chain 1 to turn, 8 sc. (8)
38. Chain 1 to turn, dec, 4 sc, dec. (6)
39. Chain 1 to turn, 6 sc. (6)
40. Chain 1 to turn, dec, 2 sc, dec. (4)
41. Chain 1 to turn, dec x 2 times. (2)
42. Chain 1 to turn, crochet around with single crochets. Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. The thread should be long enough to



sew the spot on the belly.

Sew the belly spot on the body between round 10 and 56.

Feet:

Chain 5 with Camel yarn.

1. 2 sc in the 2nd stitch from the hook, 2 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch. Continue at the bottom with 2 sc, 2 sc in the last stitch. (12)
2. 1 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc. (16)
3. 16 sc. (16)
4. inc, 1 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 5 sc. (20)
- 5-9. 20 sc. (20)
10. 2 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 7 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 5 sc. (24)
- 11-19. 24 sc. (24)
20. inc, 1 sc, inc, 20 sc, inc. (27)
21. (1 sc, inc) x 3 times, 21 sc. (30)
- 22-27. 30 sc. (30) Stuff the foot.
28. (dec, 1 sc) x 3 times, dec, 19 sc. (26)
29. (1 sc, dec) x 2 times, 20 sc. (24)
30. dec x 12 times. (12)
31. dec x 6 times. (6)

Fasten off with a sl and leave a long tail.

Pull the thread through the 6 front loops and pull tightly. Insert the thread inside towards round 1 to use it as sewing thread. Place the feet slightly diagonally under the body, the bulge comes on the front. Embroider the nails on the feet.



Arms:

Chain 5 with Camel yarn.

1. 2 sc in the 2nd stitch from the hook, 2 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch. Continue at the bottom with 2 sc, 2 sc in the last stitch. (12)
2. 1 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc. (16)
3. 16 sc. (16)

4. inc, 1 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 5 sc. (20)
- 5-11. 20 sc. (20)
12. 2 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 6 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 4 sc. (20)
- 13-14. 20 sc. (20)
15. 4 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 6 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 2 sc. (20)
- 16-18. 20 sc. (20) Stuff a little.
19. 4 sc, (inc, 1 sc) x 3 times, inc, 4 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec. (22)
20. 6 sc, (inc, 1 sc) x 3 times, inc, 6 sc, dec, 1 sc. (25)
21. dec, 23 sc. (24)
- 22-24. 24 sc. (24)
25. (2 sc, dec) x 6 times. (18)
26. (1 sc, dec) x 6. (12) Stuff a little bit more.
27. dec x 6 times. (6)

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the 6 front loops and pull tightly. Insert the thread inside towards round 1 to use it as sewing thread.

Sew the arm to the body between round 58 and 47. Sew the arm diagonally onto the body, so that Anna can hold the tulips properly later. Embroider the nails on the arms.

Tail:



1. 6 sc in a MR with Bridal white yarn. (6)
2. inc x 6 times. (12)
3. (1 sc, inc) x 6 times. (18)
4. (1 sc, inc, 1 sc) x 6 times. (24)
5. (3 sc, inc) x 6 times. (30)
6. (2 sc, inc, 2 sc) x 6 times. (36)
- 7-9. 36 sc. (36)
10. 8 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 5 sc. (32)
11. 7 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 11 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 4 sc. (28)
12. 6 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 9 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 3 sc. (24)
13. 5 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 7 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 2 sc. (20)
14. 4 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 5 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 1 sc. (16)
15. 16 sc. (16)

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail.

Stuff the tail.

Sew the tail to the body.

First put Anna down to find the right

place.



Stem of the tulip:

1. 4 sc in a MR with Lime yarn. (4)
 2. inc x 4 times. (8)
 - 3-40. 8 sc, change in the last sc of round 20 to Light coral yarn. (8) Stuff while crocheting.
 41. 8 sc. (8)
 42. inc x 8 times. (16)
 - 43-45. 16 sc. (16)
 46. (2 sc, dec) x 4 times. (12)
 47. 12 sc. (12)
 48. dec x 6 times. (6)
- Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the 6 front loops and pull tightly. Hide the thread in the stem.

Leaf of the stem:

Chain 9 with Lime yarn.

1. 2 sc in the 2nd stitch from the hook, 6 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch. Continue at the bottom with 6 sc, 2 sc in the last stitch. (20)
- 2-22. 20 sc. (20)
23. 4 sc dec, 8 sc, dec, 4 sc. (18)
- 24-25. 18 sc. (18)
26. 5 sc, dec, 7 sc, dec, 2 sc. (16)
27. 16 sc. (16)
28. 5 sc, dec, 6 sc, dec, 1 sc. (14)
29. 14 sc. (14)
30. 5 sc, dec, 5 sc, dec. (12)



31. 12 sc.
32. dec x 6 times. (6)
Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the 6 front loops and pull tightly. Insert the thread inside to the middle of the leaf and use the thread to sew the leaf on the stem. The leaf will not be stuffed.

Petals of the tulip:

- Chain 5 with Prime rose yarn.
1. 2 sc in the 2nd stitch from the hook, 2 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch. Continue at the bottom with 2 sc, 2 sc in the last stitch. (12)
 - 2-3. 12 sc. (12)
 4. 1 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc. (16)
 - 5-10. 16 sc. (16)
 11. dec, 1 sc, dec, 3 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 3 sc. (12)
 - 12-13. 12 sc. (12)
 14. dec x 6 times (6) Do not stuff.
Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the 6 front

loops and pull tightly. Insert the thread inside towards round 1 to use it as sewing thread. First sew 2 petals opposite each other on the pistil, then the other 2 petals overlapping over the first leaves. Hide the threads in the flower.

Give Anna 1 or more tulips in her arms and sew these with a few stitches so that the tulips stay in place. You can also push Anna's head a bit at an angle and fix it with a few stitches.
