## with chicks

## Needed materials:

Do you want to crocht Daisy with chicks?
This is what you need:

Scheepjes catona yarn:
105 Bridal white 50 grams
189 Royal orange 25
115 Hot red
25
208 Yellow gold
25
grams grams grams


Crochet hook 2.5 mm
Stuffing
2 safety eyes 10 mm for Daisy
2 safety eyes 7 mm for each chick
Blunt needle
Scissors
Marker
$M R=$ Magic ring
Ch = Chain stitch
SI st = slip stitch
Sc = single crochet
Hdc = half double crochet
Dc = double crochet
Chain stitch to turn
Inc = increase
Dec = decrease

## How to crochet Daisy with chicks:

## The chicken:

Chain 19 with Bridal white yarn.

1. 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, $16 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch, continue at the bottom with $16 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (40)
2. 1 sc , inc, 17 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 17 sc , inc. (44)
3. ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}$ ) $\times 2$ times, 15 sc , (inc, 1 sc ) $\times 3$ times, inc, 15 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc. (52)
4. ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}$ ) $\times 2$ times, 19 sc , (inc, 1 sc ) $\times 3$ times, inc, 19 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc. (60)
5-6. 60 sc. (60)
5. inc, 1 sc , inc, 27 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 27 sc . (64)

8-9. 64 sc. (64)
10. dec, 1 sc , dec, 27 sc , dec, 1 sc , dec, 27 sc . (60)

31. (inc, 1 scv$) \times 2$ times, inc, 9 sc , (inc, 1 sc ) $\times 3$ times, inc, 9 sc ,
inc, 1 sc. (40)

43. 28 sc. (28)
44. dec, $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 9 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 9 \mathrm{sc}$. (24)
45. 24 sc. (24)

Placet he eyes between round 39 and 40 with 3 sc in between.
46. (2 sc, dec) x 6 times. (18) Stuff further.
47. ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) x 6 times. (12)

Stuff some more.
48. dec $\times 6$ times. (6)

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the 6 front loops and pull tightly, weave the thread in the body.
7. inc, $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}, 11 \mathrm{sc}$, inc, 1 sc , inc, 11 sc . (32)
8. 32 sc . (32)
9. $\mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 11 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$, dec, 11 sc . (28)
10. 28 sc . (28)
11. dec, $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 9 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$, 9 sc. (24)
12. $\operatorname{dec} \times 2$ times, $8 \mathrm{sc}, \operatorname{dec} \times 2$ times, 8 sc . (20)
13. $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$, dec, 5 sc , dec. (16)
14. $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$, dec, 1 sc , dec, 3 sc , dec. (12)

15-16.12 sc. (12)

17.
dec $\times 6$ times. (6) Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail.
Pull the thread through the crochet work towards round 1 , in this way you use thread to sew the wing on the body.

## Beak:

## Upper part of the beak:

Chain 9 with Royal orange yarn.

1. 1 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 6 $\mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch, continue at the bottom with $7 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (18)
2. 18 sc . (18)
3. dec, 4 sc , dec, 1 sc , dec, 4 sc , dec, 1 dec. (14)
4. dec, 2 sc , dec, 1 sc , $\mathrm{dec}, 2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$. (10)
5. dec $\times 5$ times. (5) Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the crochet work towards round 1 , in this way you use the thread to sew the beak on the body.

## Lower part of the beak:

Chain 5 with Royal orange yarn.

1. 1 sc in the second stitch from the hook, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch, continue at the bottom with $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (10)
$2-4 . \quad 10 \mathrm{sc}$. (10)
2. dec $\times 5$ times. (5)

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the crochet work towards round 1, in this way you use the thread to sew the beak on the body.

## Wattle 2x:

6 sc in a magic ring with Hot red yarn.

1. $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}, 2$ sc , inc, 1 sc .

(8)
2. 8 sc . (8)
3. $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$, dec. (6)
4. dec, $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$. (4)
5. 4 sc . (4)

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Sew the 2 wattles under the beak. (see picture).

## Comb:

Chain 9 with Hot red yarn.

1. 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 6 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch, continue at the bottom with $6 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (20)
2. 20 sc . (20)
3. 1 sc , inc, 7 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 7 sc , inc. (24)
4. 24 sc . (24)
5. 1 sc more, fold your work in half, now crochet *4 sc through both parts, turn, chain 1 to turn, 4 sc , turn, chain 1 to turn, $1 \mathrm{hdc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in a sc, $1 \mathrm{hdc}, 1 \mathrm{scv}, 1 \mathrm{hdc}$ in the $4^{\text {th }} \mathrm{sc}$ of the 4 sc through both parts*. Repeat from * till * another 2 times.
Fasten off with a sl

st and leave a long tail.
Pull the thread through the crochet work towards round 1, in this way you use the thread to sew the comb on the head.

## Legs 2x:

Chain7 with Royal orange yarn.

1. 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 4 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch, continue at the bottom with $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (16)
2. 16 sc . (16)
3. 1 sc , inc, 5 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 5 sc , inc. (20)
4. 20 sc . (20)
5. 1 sc , inc, 7 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 7 sc , inc. (24) 6-7. 24 sc . (24)
6. Crochet 3 sc more so that you are on the side, fold your work in half and close it with 12 sc.
Now we are going to make the toes. Look closely at the pictures.
7. turn, chain 1 to turn, 4 sc , turn, chain 1 to turn, 4 sc , turn, chain 1 to turn, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 1$ hdc, 2 dc in a sc, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{hdc}$ in the $4^{\text {th }} \mathrm{sc}$ of the first 4 sc of the toe.
Fasten off with a sl stand leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the crochet work towards round 1 , in this way you use the thread to sew the legs on the body.


## Tail:

Chain 5 with Bridal white yarn.

1. 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 2 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch, continue at the bottom with $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (12)
2. 12 sc . (12)
3. 1 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc. (16)

4-5. 16 sc. (16)
6. $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$, dec, 3 sc , dec.
(12)
7. $\quad 12 \mathrm{sc}$. (12)
8. $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$. (8)
9. dec $x 4$ times. (4)

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the crochet work towards round 1 , in this way you use the thread to sew the tail on the body.

## Chick:

Chain 5 with Yellow gold yarn.

1. 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 2 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch, continue at the bottom with $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (12)
2. 1 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc. (16)
3. 1 sc , inc, 5 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 5 sc , inc. (20)
4. inc, 1 sc , inc, 7 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 7 sc . (24)
5. ( 1 sc, inc) $\times 3$ times, 5 sc , (inc, 1 sc$) \times 3$ times, inc, 5 sc, inc. (32)
6. 32 sc . (32)
7. 2 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 13 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 11 sc. (36)
8-11. 36 sc. (36)
8. (dec, 1 sc ) $\times 3$ times, dec, 7 sc , (dec, 1 sc ) $x$ 3 times, dec, 7 sc. (28)
$13-14.28 \mathrm{sc}$. (28)
9. ( 1 sc, dec) $\times 2$ times, $9 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 8$ sc. (24)
10. 24 sc . (24)

Stuff the body a little.
17. ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) $\times 2$ times, $7 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 6$ sc. (20)
18. 20 sc. (20)

Place the eyes between round 12 and 13 with 3 sc in between.
19. dec, $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 5 \mathrm{sc}$, dec, $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 5 \mathrm{sc}$. (16)
20. 16 sc. (16)

Stuff the body partially.
21. dec, $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$, $\mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$. (12)

Stuff the bodu further.

22. dec $\times 6$ times. (6)

Pull the thread through the 6 front loops and pull tightly, weave the thread in the body.

## Beak:

Chain 5 with Royal orange yarn.

1. 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 2 $\mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch, continue at the bottom with $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (12)
2. 3 sc , inc, 5 sc , inc, 2 sc . (14)

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Fold the beak in half and sew the bottom on the body, just below the eyes.

## Crest:

Chain 11 with Hot red
 yarn.

1. 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 8 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch, continue at the bottom with $8 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (24)
2. 24 sc . (24)
3. 1 sc , fold your work in half and crochet through both parts 4 sc , turn, chain 1 to turn, 4 sc , turn, turn 1 to turn, $1 \mathrm{hdc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in a sc, $1 \mathrm{hdc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$, now crochet 1 hdc in the $4^{\text {th }}$ sc of the first 4 sc of the closing of the crest.
Repeat 2 times, fasten off and pull the thread through the crochet work towards round 1 , in this way you use the thread to sew the crest on the head.
Sew the crest on the head according the picture.

## Wings:

Chain 5 with Yellow gold yarn.

1. 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 2 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch, continue at the bottom with $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (12)
2. 12 sc . (12)
3. 1 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc. (16)
4. 1 sc , inc, 5 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 5 sc , inc. (20)
5. $1 \mathrm{sc}, \operatorname{dec} \times 2$ times, 1 sc , dec $\times 2$ times, 1 sc, dec $\times 2$ times, 1 sc , dec $\times 2$ times. (12)
6. 12 scv . (12)
7. dec $\times 6$ times. (6)

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail, pull the thread through the 6 front loops and pull tightly.
Pull the thread through the crochet work towards round 1 , in this way you use the thread to sew the wing on the body. Sew the wings on the sides of the body between round 13 and 14 .
