2 safety eyes 10 mm (duckling)
Crochet needle 2,5 (12 for UK and C/2 for VS)
Polyester for stuffing
Tapestry needle

## How to crochet Elaine and her baby duckling:

## Do you want to crochet Elaine without legs?

Then start the body at row 1 of the
"Body and head" section. Only row 8 and 9 are adjusted.
Round 8: 56 sc . (56)
Round 9: inc, 2 sc , inc, 3sc, inc, 1sc, inc, 47sc. (60)
Continue working according to the pattern.

## The legs 2x:

Chain 4 with Apricot color yarn.
Round 1: 2 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ stitch from the hook, 1 $\mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch.
Continue at the bottom with $1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (10)
Round 2: 10 sc . (10)
Round 3: 1 sc , inc, 2 sc , inc, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next sc, 2 sc, inc. (14)
Round 4: 14 sc . (14)
Round 5 : inc, 1 sc , inc, 4 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 4 sc .
(18)

Round 6: (1 sc, inc) x 3 times, 2 sc, (inc, 1 sc ) x 3 times, inc, 2 sc, inc. (26)
Round 7: (1 sc, inc) x 3 times, inc, 6 sc , (inc, 1 sc ) $x 3$ times, inc, 6 sc. (34)
Round 8-9: 34 sc . (34)

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail.
Crochet another leg.
Both legs are tied off. Fill the legs tightly or fill the legs partially with plastic granules, so that Elaine stands even better. Do not fill the flippers.

## The body and the head:

Chain 15 with Bridal white color yarn.
Round 1: 2 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ stitch from the hook, 12 $\mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch.
Continue at the bottom with $12 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (32)
Round 2: 1 sc , inc, 13 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 13 sc , inc. (36)

Round 3: (1 sc, inc) x 2 times, 29 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc. (40)

Round 4: (inc, 1 sc ) $\times 2$ times, inc, 13 sc , (inc, 1 sc) $x 3$ times, inc, 13 sc , inc, 1 sc . (48)
Round 5: 48 sc . (48)
Round 6: inc, 3 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 39 sc , inc, 1 sc . (52)

Round 7: 1 sc , inc, 3 sc, inc, 22 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 21 sc. (56)
Round 8: 12 sc , now crochet with 7 sc (on single crochet 2,1 en $14,13,12,11$ and 10 of the last round of the leg) the first leg onto the body. First crochet through the inside of the leg and then through the sc of the body. 28 sc, now crochet the second leg onto the body (on single crochet 4 till 10
of the last round of the leg), 2 sc . (56)
Round 9: inc, 1 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 3 sc , now crochet the 7 sc of the outside of the leg ( $n o t$ the stitches you made on the previous round), 28 sc , now crochet the stitches on the outside of the leg again, 2 sc . (60)
Round 10: 2 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 25 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 21 sc . (66)
Round 11: 41 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 22 sc . (68)
Round 12-14: 68 sc . (68)

Round 62: 8 sc , dec, $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 9 \mathrm{sc}$, ( $\mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) x 2 times. (24)
Round 63: (dec, 2 sc ) x 6 times. (18)
Stuff a little more.
Round 64: (dec, 1 sc ) x 6 times. (12)
Round 65: dec $x 6$ times. (6)
Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the 6 front loops and pull tightly. Hide the thread into the head.

## Beak:

Chain 5 with Apricot color yarn.
Round 1: 2 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ stitch from the hook, 2 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch.
Continue at the bottom with $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (12)
Round 2: inc, 1 sc , inc, 3 sc in een sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 5 sc. (18)
Round 3-4: 18 sc . (18)
Round 5: 2 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next sc, 3 sc, inc, 5 sc. (22)
Round 6: 22 sc . (22)
Round 7: 4 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc $\times 2$ times, 1 sc , inc x 2 times, 3 sc , inc, 5 sc . (28)
Round 8: 28 sc . (28)
Round 9: 4 sc , inc $\times 2$ times, 6 sc , inc $\times 3$ times, 6 sc, inc $x 2$ times, 4 sc, inc. (36)
Round 10: 3 sl st, 4 sc, 6 sl st, 6 sc, 6 sl st, 4 sc, 4 sl st, 2 sc, 1 sl st. (36)
Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Sew the on the head between round 52 and 40 .
Fill the beak slightly, sew the nostrils on the beak with a thread and pull the thread a little taut so that the beak narrows a bit.
Fasten off and hide the thread into the beak.

## Wing 2x:

Chain 7 with Bridal white color yarn.
Round 1: 2 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ stitch from the hook, 4 $\mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch.
Continue at the bottom with $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (16)
Round 2: 1 sc , inc, 5 sc in the next sc, inc, 1 sc , inc, 5 sc, inc. (20)
Round 3: 20 sc. (20)
Round 4: 1 sc , inc, 7 sc in the next sc, inc, 1 sc , inc, 7 sc, inc. (24)
Round 5-6: 24 sc . (24)
Round 7: inc, 1 sc , inc, 9 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 9 sc . (28)

Round 8-11: 28 sc. (28)
Round 12: (1 sc, dec) x 2 times, 22 sc . (26)
Round 13: 26 sc . (26)
Round 14: dec, 1 sc , dec, 21 sc . (24)
Round 15: 24 sc. (24)
Round 16: dec $\times 2$ times, 8 sc , dec $\times 2$ times, 8 sc. (20)

The wings are not stuffed.
Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail Pull the thread through the 6 front loops and pull tightly. Insert the thread inside to row 1, this way the thread can be used as sewing thread. Sew the wing on the body between round 18 and 26. Sew round 1 on the body only, the rest of the wing does not need to be sewn on.


## Flower on the head:

Round 1: Crochet 6 sc in a MR with Apricot color yarn. (6)
Round 2: (inc, 1 sc ) 3 times. (9)
Change to Lemonade yarn in the last sc.
Round 3: Now crochet 8 times a popcorn stitch with a treble crochet, close with a sl st and fasten off. You can crochet the flower in different colors. Sew the flower(s) on Elaine's head the way you like it.

## The body and the head of the baby duckling:

Chain 9 with Lemonade color yarn.
Round 1: 2 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ stitch from the hook, 6 $\mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch.
Continue at the bottom with $6 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (20)
Round 2: 1 sc , inc, 7 sc , inc, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next sc, 7 sc, inc. (24)
Round 3: 1 sc , inc, 9 sc , inc, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next sc, 9 sc, inc. (28)
Round 4: inc, 1 sc , inc, 11 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 11 sc . (32)

Round 5: (1 sc, inc) x 3 times, 25 sc, inc. (36)

Round 48: ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) x 6 times. (12)

Round 49: dec $x 6$ times. (6)
Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the 6 front loops
and pull tightly. Hide the thread into the head.

## Beak of the baby duckling:

Chain 4 with Apricot yarn.
Round 1: 2 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ stitch from the hook, 1 $\mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. Continue at the bottom with $1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (10)
Round 2: inc, 4 sc , inc, 4 sc . (12)
Round 3: 3 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 6 sc . (14)
Round 4: 3 sc , inc $\times 2$ times, 1 sc , inc $\times 2$ times, 6 sc. (18)

Round 5: 2 sc , inc, 9 sc , inc, 5 sc . (20)
Round 6: 8 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 9 sc . (22)
Round 7: 3 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 2 sc , inc $\times 2$ times, 1 sc , inc $\times 2$ times, 2 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 4 sc. (30)
Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Sew the beak on the head between round 41 and 33 . Fill the beak slightly, sew the nostrils on the beak with a thread and pull the thread a little taut so that the beak narrows a bit. Fasten off and hide the thread into the beak.

## Wing baby duckling $\mathbf{2 x}$ :

Chain 6 with Lemonade color yarn.
Round 1: 2 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ stitch from the hook, 3 $\mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch.
Continue at the bottom with 3 v , 2 sc in the laststitch. (14)
Round 2: 1 sc , inc, 4 sc , inc, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next sc, 4 sc, inc. (18)
Round 3: 18 sc . (18)
Round 4: 1 sc , inc, 6 sc , inc, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next sc, 6 sc, inc. (22)
Round 5-6: 22 sc. (22)
Round 7: 10 sc, dec, 1 sc , dec, 7 sc . (20)
Round 8: 20 sc . (20)
Round 9: $9 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 6 \mathrm{sc}$. (18)
Round 10: dec, 1 sc , dec, 4 sc , dec, 1 sc , dec, 4 sc. (14)
Round 11-12: 14 sc. (14)
Round 13: dec, 1 sc , dec, 9 sc . (12)
Round 14: dec $x 6$ times. (6)
The wings are not stuffed.
Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail Pull the thread through the 6 front loops and pull tightly. Insert the thread inside to row 1, this way the thread can be used as sewing thread. Sew the wing on the body between round 15 and 20. Sew round 1 on the body only, the rest of the wing does not need to be sewn on.


## Haken \& Maken

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
