Do you want to crochet Joep?

This is what you need:

Scheepjes catona:	249	Champagne	100 grams
	255	Shell	25 grams
	208	Yellow gold	25 grams

*The names of the cotton colors are named in the pattern.

2 safety eyes 10mm
Crochet hook 2.5 mm
Polyester stuffing
tapestry needle
Scissors
Marker

Stitches used:

MR	Magic ring
Ch	Chain
Sl st	Slip stitch
Sc	Single crochet
HDC	Half Double Crochet
DC	Double Crochet
Incr	Increase
Decr	Decrease

Pattern is written in VS terms.



How to crochet Joep:

The body and head:

Chain 9 with Champagne color yarn.

Round 1: 2 sc in the 2^e stitch from the hook, 6 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch, continue at the bottom with 6 sc, 2 sc in the last stitch. (20)
Round 2: 1 sc, inc, 7 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 7 sc, inc. (24)
Round 3: (1 sc, inc) x 2 times, 5 sc, (inc, 1 sc) x 3 times, inc, 5 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc. (32)
Round 4: (inc, 1 sc) x 2 times, inc, 9 sc, (inc, 1 sc) x 3 times, inc, 9 sc, inc, 1 sc. (40)
Round 5: (1 sc, inc) x 2 times, 17 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 2 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 1 sc. (48)
Round 6: 48 sc. (48)
Round 7: 2 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 19 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 4 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 2 sc. (56)

Round 51: 4 sc, (inc, 1 sc) x 7, inc, 5 sc, (inc, 1 sc) x 7, inc, 1 sc. (56)

Round 52-53: 56 sc. (56)

Round 54: 14 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 9 sc, (inc) x 2 times, 1 sc, inc x 2 times, 9 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 9 sc. (56)

Round 55-56: 56 sc. (56)

Round 57: 30 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 23 sc. (58)

Round 58: 31 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 24 sc. (60)

Round 59: 60 sc. (60) Stuff a little bit more.

Round 60: 14 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 10 sc, dec x 2 times, 1 sc, dec x 2 times, 10 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 7 sc. (52)

Round 61: 52 sc. (52)

Round 62: 13 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 7 sc, dec x 2 times, 1 sc, dec x 2 times, 7 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 6 sc. (44)

Round 63: 44 sc. (44)

Round 64: 24 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 15 sc. (42)

Round 65: 23 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 14 sc. (40)

Round 66: 19 sc, (dec, 1 sc) x 3 times, dec, 10 sc. (36)

Round 67: 10 sc, (dec, 1 sc) x 2 times, (dec, 4 sc) x 2 times, (dec, 1 sc) x 2 times, dec. (29)

Round 68: 19 sc, dec, 8 sc. (28)

Round 69: (dec, 1 sc) x 3 times, dec, 17 sc. (24)
Place the eyes between round 63 and 64 with 8 sc in between. (Check that the eyes are in the middle of the head, pay attention to the nose, it comes on round 58-60)

Round 70: (dec, 2 sc) x 6 times. (18) Stuff a little.

Round 71: (1 sc, dec) x 6 times. (12)
Stuff a little more.

Round 72: dec x 6 times. (6)

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the 6 front loops and pull tightly, hide the thread in the head.

Ears:

Chain 7 with Champagne color yarn.

Round 1: 2 sc in the 2^e stitch from the hook, 4 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch, continue at the bottom with 4 sc, 2 sc in the last stitch. (16)

Round 2: 1 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc. (20)

Round 3: 20 sc. (20)

Round 4: 1 sc, inc, 7 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 7 sc, inc. (24)

Round 5-6: 24 sc. (24)

Round 7: inc, 1 sc, inc, 9 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 9 sc. (28)

Round 8: 28 sc. (28)

Round 9: dec, 1 sc, dec, 9 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 9 sc. (24)

Round 10: 24 sc. (24)

Round 11: dec, 1 sc, dec, 7 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 7 sc. (20)

Round 12: dec x 2 times, 6 sc, dec x 2 times, 6 sc. (16)

Round 13: 1 sc, dec, 3 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 3 sc,



dec. (12)

Round 14: dec x 6 times. (6)

The ears are not stuffed.

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the 6 front loops and pull tightly. Insert the thread inside towards round 1, so you can use the thread for sewing.

Inner ear:

Chain 5 with Shell color yarn.

Round 1: 2 sc in the 2^e stitch from the hook, 2 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch, continue at the bottom with 2 sc, 2 sc in the last stitch. (12)

Round 2: 1 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc. (16)

Round 3: (1 sc, inc) x 8 times. (24)

Sew the inner ears on the ears and hide the thread inside the ear.

Sew the ears on the head between round 60 and 65, there are approximately 5 sc between the eye and the ear.

Eyebrows, nose and mouth:

Embroider the eyebrows, nose and mouth on Joep's head, according to the pictures.

Belly part:

Chain 11 with Shell color yarn.

Row 1: 1 sc in the 2^e stitch from the hook, 9 sc. (10)

Row 2: chain 1 to turn, inc, 8 sc, inc. (12)

Row 3: chain 1 to turn, inc, 10 sc, inc. (14)

Row 4: chain 1 to turn, inc, 12 sc, inc. (16)

Row 5-6: chain 1 to turn, 16 sc. (16)

Row 7: chain 1 to turn, inc, 14 sc, inc. (18)

Row 8-10: chain 1 to turn, 18 sc. (18)

Row 11: chain 1 to turn, dec, 14 sc, dec. (16)

Row 12: chain 1 to turn, 16 sc. (16)

Row 13: chain 1 to turn dec, 12 sc, dec. (14)

Row 14: chain 1 to turn, 14 sc. (14)

Row 15: chain 1 to turn, dec, 10 sc, dec. (12)

Row 16: chain 1 to turn, dec, 8 sc, dec. (10)

Row 17: chain 1 to turn, 10 sc. (10)

Row 18: chain 1 to turn, dec, 6 sc, dec. (8)

Row 19-22: chain 1 to turn, 8 sc. (8)

Row 23: chain 1 to turn, dec, 4 sc, dec. (6)

Row 24: chain 1 to turn, dec, 2 sc, dec. (4)

Row 25: chain 1 to turn, (dec) x 2 times. (2)

chain 1 to turn, crochet around with single crochets, fasten off and leave a tail which is long enough to sew the

whole belly part on the body. Sew the belly part on the body between round 10 and 39.

Arms:

Chain 5 with Champagne color yarn.

Round 1: 2 sc in the 2^e stitch from the hook, 2 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch, continue at the bottom with 2 sc, 2 sc in the last stitch. (12)

Round 2-7: 12 sc. (12)

Round 8: 1 sc, inc, 5 sc, dec, 3 sc. (12)

Round 9: 12 sc. (12)

Round 10: 2 sc, inc, 5 sc, dec, 2 sc. (12)

Round 11-12: 12 sc. (12)

Round 13: 1 sc, inc x 4 times, 7 sc. (16)

Round 14: 3 sc, inc x 4 times, 9 sc. (20)

Round 15: 20 sc. Stuff a little.

Round 16: 5 sc, dec x 4 times, 7 sc. (16)

Round 17: 3 sc, dec x 4 times, 5 sc. (12)

Stuff a little more.

Round 18: dec x 6 times. (6)

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the 6 front loops and pull tightly. Insert the thread inside towards round 1, so you can use the thread for sewing.

Sew the arms on the body between round 37 and round 42.

Embroider the nails on the front legs with Shell yarn, according to the pictures.

Feet:

Chain 5 with Champagne color yarn.

Round 1: 2 sc in the 2^e stitch from the hook, 2 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch, continue at the bottom with 2 sc, 2 sc in the last stitch. (12)

Round 2: 1 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc. (16)

Round 3-9: 16 sc. (16)

Round 10: (1 sc, inc) x 2 times, 5 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 4 sc. (20)

Round 11-15: 20 sc. (20)

Round 16: 7 sc, inc x 2 times, 1 sc, inc x 2 times, 8 sc. (24)

Round 17: 7 sc, inc x 4 times, 1 sc, inc x 4 times, 8 sc. (32)

Round 18: 32 sc. (32)

Round 19: 12 sc, dec x 2 times, 1 sc, dec x 2 times, 11 sc. (28)

Round 20: 12 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 11 sc. (26)

Round 21: 11 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 10 sc. (24)

Round 22: (2 sc, dec) x 6 times. (18) Stuff a little.

Round 23: (1 sc, dec) x 6 times. (12)

Stuff a little more.

Round 24: dec x 6 times. (6)

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the 6 front loops and pull tightly. Insert the thread



inside towards round 1, so you can use the thread for sewing.
Sew the feet under the body between round 6 and 10. Sew the legs slightly slanting outwards, so Joep will stand better.
Embroider the nails on the feet with Shell yarn, according to the pictures.
Sew the tail on the body between round 6 and 13. First put Joep down (with his feet attached) to determine the right place.

Tail:

Round 1: 4 sc in a MR with Shell color yarn. (4)

Round 2: inc x 4 times. (8)

Round 3-32: 8 sc. (8)

Round 33: inc, 3 sc, inc, 3 sc. (10)

Round 34-40: 10 sc. (10)

Round 41: inc, 4 sc, inc, 4 sc. (12)

Round 42-47: 12 sc. (12)

The tail is not stuffed.

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Sew the tail to Joep after you have sewn on the feet, so you can better determine the position of the tail.



The heart of cheese:

Crochet the first part of the heart twice.

Round 1: 6 sc in a MR with Yellow gold color yarn. (6)

Round 2: inc x 6 times. (12)

Round 3: (1 sc, inc) x 6 times. (18)

Round 4: (1 sc, inc, 1 sc) x 6 times. (24)

Round 5-7: 24 sc. (24)

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Crochet another piece but don't fasten off.

Round 8: Insert the crochet hook through both parts and crochet the first sc on the first part of the heart, crochet 23 sc more on this part. (The first part now has 24 sc)

Now insert the hook again through both parts for sc number 25 on the second part of the heart and crochet 23 sc on this part. (The second part now also has 24 sc)
You have now crocheted a total of 48 sc. This is the end of round 8.

Round 9: 48 sc. (48)

Round 10: dec, 6 sc, now **crochet in the back loops only** dec x 2 times, 1 sc, dec x 2 times, now **crochet in both loops again** 7 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 9 sc, dec, 8 sc. (40)

Round 11: 5 sc, dec x 2 times, 1 sc, dec x 2 times, 26 sc. (36)

Round 12: dec, 1 sc, dec x 2 times, 1 sc, dec x 2 times, 2 sc, dec, 7 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 8 sc. (28)

Round 13: 28 sc. (28)

Round 14: dec, now **crochet in the front loops only** inc x 2 times, 1 sc, inc x 2 times, now **crochet in both loops again** 3 sc, dec, 5 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 6 sc. (28)

Round 15: 5 sc, inc x 2 times, 21 sc. (30)

Round 16: dec, 3 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 5 sc. (24)

Round 17: 24 sc. (24)

Round 18: dec, 2 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 3 sc, dec, 2 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 3 sc. (18)

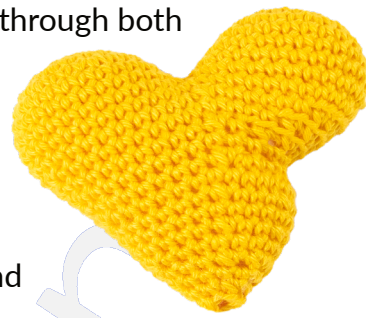
Round 19: 18 sc. (18) Stuff the heart a little.

Round 20: dec x 2 times, 1 sc, dec, 2 sc, dec x 2 times, 1 sc, dec, 2 sc. (12)

Round 21: 12 sc. (12) Stuff the heart.

Round 22: dec x 6 times. (12)

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the 6 front loops and pull tightly, hide the thread into the heart. Sew the heart to Joep's legs with a few stitches and hide the thread into the heart.



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
