## How to crochet Mia:

## Body and head:

Chain 21 with Soft beige color yarn.
Round 1: Starting from the second ch from the hook incr in chain, 18sc, double increase in last chain, continue at the bottom 18sc, 2 sc in last sc. (44)

Round 2: 1sc, incr, 19sc, incr, 1sc, incr, 19sc, incr. (48)

Round 3: (incr, 1sc) x2, incr, 17sc, (incr, 1sc) x3, incr, 17sc, incr, 1sc. (56)
Round 4: (1sc, incr) x2, 25sc, incr, 1sc, incr, 24sc. (60)

Round 5: (incr, 1sc) x3, incr, 23sc, (incr, 1sc) x3, incr, 23sc. (68)

Round 65: 48sc. (48) continue stuffing.
Round 66: 10sc, (decr, 1sc) x3, decr, 13sc, (decr, 1sc) x3, decr, 3sc. (40)
Round 67: 40sc. (40)
Round 68: 8sc, (decr, 1sc) x3, decr, 9sc,
(decr, 1sc) x3, decr, 1sc. (32)
Round 69: 32sc. (32)
Round 70: decr, 5 sc , (decr, 1sc) x3, decr, 5 sc , (decr, 1sc) x3. (24)
Round 71: (2sc, decr) x6. (18)
Stuff a little more.
Round 72: (1sc, decr) x6. (12)
Round 73: (decr) $\times 6$. (6)

Fasten off with slip stitch and leave a long tail for sewing. Sew the tread through the front 6 loops and pull the yarn gently tight. Fasten off and weave in your end.

## Muzzle:

Chain 9 with Bridal white color yarn.
Round 1: Starting from the second ch from the hook incr in chain, 6sc, double increase in last chain, continue at the bottom 6 sc , incr in last sc. (20)

Round 2: 1sc, incr, 7sc, incr, 1sc, incr, 7sc, incr. (24)

Round 3: 2sc, incr, 7sc, incr, 3sc, incr, 7sc, incr, 1sc. (28)
Round 4: 28sc. (28)
Round 5: incr, 1sc, incr, 11sc, incr, 1sc, incr, 11sc. (32)

Round 6: (1sc, incr) x3, 9sc, (incr, 1sc) x3, incr, 9 sc , incr. (40)
Round 7-8: 40sc. (40)
Fasten off with slip stitch and leave a long tail for sewing. Sew the muzzle between 35th and 48th row (just beneath the eyes) on the head. Stuff firmly while sewing.

## Nose:

Chain 9 with Old rose color yarn.
Round 1: Starting from the second ch from the hook 1sc, 7sc. (8)
Round 2: chain 1, turn, decr, 4sc, decr. (6)
Round 3: chain 1, turn, decr, 2 sc , decr. (4)
Round 4: chain 1, turn, (decr) x2. (2)
Round 5: chain 1, turn, crochet sc all around.
Fasten off with slipstitch, leave a long tail for
sewing. Sew the nose between 3rd and 7th row.
Weave in your end. With Soft beige color yarn sew the mouth on the muzzle.
With Old rose color yarn sew the eyebrows between 57th and 58th row. Use the picture below as a guideline.

## Ears 2x:

Chain 15 with Soft
beige color yarn.
Round 1: Starting from the second ch from the hook 1sc in chain, 12 sc , 2sc in last chain. Continue at the bottom, 13sc. (28)
Round 2: 28sc. (28)
Round 3: 1sc, decr, 9 sc , decr,
1 sc , decr, 9 sc , decr. (24)
Round 4: 24sc. (24)
Round 5: 1sc, decr, 7sc, decr, 1 sc , decr, 7sc, decr. (20)
Round 6: 20sc. (20)
Round 7: 1sc, decr, 5sc, decr, 1sc, decr, 5 sc , decr.
(16)

Round 8: 16sc. (16)
Round 9: 1sc, decr, 3sc, decr, 1sc, decr, 3sc, decr. (12)

Round 10: 12sc. (12)
Round 11: (decr) x6. (6)
Fasten off with slip stitch and leave a long tail for sewing. Sew the tread through the front 6 loops and pull the yarn gently tight. Sew your thread back at first row. In this way you can use your thread as a sewing thread to sew the ears.

## Inner ear 2x:

With Old rose color yarn make a MR with 6sc. (6) Round 1: (incr) x6. (12)
Round 2: (incr) $\times 4,2 \mathrm{sc}$, (incr) $\times 4$, 2 sc . (20)
Fasten off with slip stitch and leave a long tail for sewing. Sew the inner ear in the middle of the outer ear between first and 8th row of the outer ear. Sew ears on the head between 53th and 64th row.

## Feet 2x:

With Bridal white color chain 5.
Round 1: Starting from the second ch from the hook incr in chain, 2 sc , double increase in last chain, continue at the bottom, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in last sc. (12)

Round 2: 1sc, (incr) $\times 2$, 1sc, (incr) $\times 2$, 1sc, (incr) x2, 1sc, (incr) x2. (20)
Round 3: 1sc, incr, 7sc, incr, 1sc, incr, 7sc, incr. (24)

Round 4: 1sc, incr, 9sc, incr, 1sc, incr, 9sc, incr. (28)

Round 5: 28sc. (28)
Round 6: incr, 1sc, incr, 11sc, incr, 1sc, incr, 11sc. (32)

Round 7: 32sc. (32)
Round 8: (1sc, incr) x2, 13sc, incr, 1sc, incr, 12sc. (36)

Round 9: 36sc. (36)
Round 10: 2 sc , incr, 1 sc , incr, 15 sc , incr, 1 sc , incr, 13sc. (40)
Round 11: 40sc. (40)
Round 12: 3sc, incr, 1sc, incr, 17sc, incr, 1sc, incr, 14sc. (44)
Round 13-19: 44sc. (44)
Round 20: 6sc, decr, 1sc, decr, 17sc, decr, 1sc, decr, 11sc. (40)
Round 21: 40sc. (40)
Round 22: 5 sc , decr, 1sc, decr, 15sc, decr, 1sc, decr, 10sc. (36)
Round 23: 1sc, (decr, 1sc) x3, decr, 7sc, (decr, 1 sc ) $\times 3$, decr, 6sc. (28)
Round 24: (decr, 1sc) x3, decr, 3sc, (decr, 1sc) x3, decr, 3sc. (20)
Start filling the foot.
Round 25: (1sc, decr) x2, 5sc, decr, 1sc, decr, 4sc.
(16)

Round 26: 16sc. (16)
Round 27: decr, 1sc, decr, 3sc, decr, 1sc, decr, 3sc. (12) Stuff the foot a little more.
Round 28: (decr) x6. (6)

Fasten off with a slip stitch and leave a long tail for sewing. Sew the thread through the front 6 loops and tighten. Insert the thread inside to row 3 , in this way you can use the thread as a sewing thread.
Sew with Soft beige color yarn toes on the foot by sewing the thread between 18th and 23rd row and tightening the thread. Fasten off.

## Hind paw 2x:

Chain 5 with Soft rose color yarn.
Round 1: Starting from the second ch from the hook incr in chain, 2sc, double increase in last chain,
continue at the bottom, 2 sc , incr in last sc. (12)
Round 2: 1sc, (incr) x2, 1sc, (incr) x2, 1sc, (incr) x2, 1sc, (incr) x2. (20)
Round 3: 1sc, incr, 7sc, incr, 1sc, incr, 7 HDC, incr. (24)
Round 4: chain 1, turn, crochet sc all around. Fasten off with slip stitch and leave a long tail for sewing. Sew the hind paw on the foot between 4th and 12th row.

## Fore paw:

## Small 2x for each foot:

With Soft rose color yarn make a MR with 6sc. Fasten off with slip stitch and leave a long tail for sewing.

## Large 1 x for each foot:

With Soft rose color yarn make a MR with 6sc. ( 2 x incr, 1 sc ) x2. (10)
Fasten off with slip stitch and leave a long tail for sewing.

Sew the foot cushions on the foot, according to the picture above.

FIRST sew the front legs onto the body, and then the back legs.

## Front leg 2x:

Chain 5 with Bridal white color yarn.
Round 1: Starting from the second ch from the hook incr in chain, 2 sc , double increase in last chain, continue at the bottom, 2 sc , incr in last sc. (12)
Round 2: 1sc, (incr) x2, 1sc, (incr) $\times 2$, 1sc, (incr) $\times 2$, 1sc, (incr) x2. (20)
Round 3: 20sc. (20)
Round 4: 1sc, (incr) x2, 5sc, (incr) x2, 10sc. (24)
Round 5: 2sc, (incr) $\times 2,7 \mathrm{sc}$, (incr) x2, 11sc. (28)
Round 6-7: 28sc. (28)

Round 8: 3sc, (decr) $\times 2$, 7 sc , (decr) $\times 2$, 10sc. (24)
Round 9: 3sc, (decr) x2, 3sc, (decr) x2, 10sc. (20)
Round 10: 1sc, (decr) x2, 4sc, (decr) x2, 7sc. (16) In last sc change color to Soft beige color yarn.
Round 11-25: 16sc. (16)
Stuff the paw firmly, stuff the leg lightly.
Round 26: 3sc, decr, 1sc, decr, 3sc, decr, 1sc, decr. (12)
Round 27-28: 12sc. (12)
Round 29: Stuff the leg a little more. Fold the leg and crochet the opposite stitches with 6sc together. Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.
Sew the toes with soft rose color on the front legs between row 9 on the front and row 9 on the back. Tighten the thread and tie off. Weave in the thread in the leg.
Sew the front legs on the body on 31st row of the body. If necessary, attach the front leg to the body with a few stitches on the back of the leg, then Mia will stand better.
Sew the hind legs on the body between 8th and 20th row.

## Tail:

With Bridal white color yarn make a MR with 6sc.
Round 1: (incr, 2sc) x2. (8)
Round 2: 1sc, incr, 3sc, incr, 2sc. (10)
Round 3: 1sc, incr, 1 sc , incr, 2 sc , incr, 1 sc , incr, 1sc. (14)
Round 4-10: 14sc. (14) In last stitch change color to Soft beige color.
Round 11-60: 14sc. (14)
Fasten off with slip stitch and leave a long tail for sewing. Sew the tail on the body between 9th and 15th row.Fasten off and weave in your end.

## Bow 2x:

The bow consists of 2 triangles and a center ball. All parts will be crocheted separately.

## Triangle:

Chain 15 with Soft rose color yarn.
Round 1: Starting from the second ch from the hook 1sc, 12sc, incr in last chain, continue at the bottom, 13sc. (28)
Round 2: 28sc. (28)
Round 3: 1sc, decr, 9 sc , decr, 1sc, decr, 9 sc , decr. (24)

Round 4-5: 24sc. (24)
Round 6: 1sc, decr, 7sc, decr, 1sc, decr, 7sc, decr. (20)

Round 7-8: 20sc. (20)
Round 9: 1sc, decr, 5sc, decr, 1sc, decr, 5sc, decr. (24)

Round 10: 16sc. (16)
Round 11: 1sc, decr, 3sc, decr, 1sc, decr, 3sc, decr. (12)
Round 12-13: 12sc. (12)
Crochet 2 extra sc, fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing. Lightly fill the triangle.

## Center ball:

Round 1: With Old rose color yarn make a MR with 6sc. (6)
Round 2: (incr) x6. (12)

Round 3: incr, 1sc, incr, 3sc, incr, 1sc, incr, 3sc. (16)
Round 4-6: 16sc. (16)

Round 7: decr, 1sc,
decr, 3sc, decr, 1sc, decr, 3sc. (12)
Round 8: (decr) x6.(6)
Tie off with a slip stitch and a long thread. Sew the thread through the 6 front loops and tighten. Tie off and work away the thread in the ball.

Sew the 2 triangles to the back of the ball and tie off.

## Collar:

Chain 31 with Soft rose color yarn.
Round 1: Starting from the second ch from the hook 1sc, 28sc, incr in last chain, continue at the bottom, 29sc. (60)
Round 2: Fasten off with slip stitch and leave a long tail for sewing. Sew the collar on one side at the back side of the bow. Place the collar around the neck of Mia and sew the other side on the back side of the bow.

Round 2: 1 sc , inc, 19 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 19 sc , inc. (48)

Round 3: (inc, 1 sc ) x 2 times, inc, 17 sc , (inc, 1 sc) $x 3$ times, inc, 17 sc , inc, 1 sc . (56)
Round 4: ( 1 sc , inc) $\times 2$ times, 25 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 24 sc. (60)
Round 5: (inc, 1 sc ) $\times 3$ times, inc, 23 sc , (inc, 1 sc) $x 3$ times, inc, 23 sc. (68)
Round 6: (inc, 1 sc ) x 5 times, inc, 23 sc , (inc, 1

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the 6 front loops and pull tightly. Hide the thread in the head.

With Light navy color yarn embroider the eyebrows on the head between round 51 and 53 , according to the picture below.

## Muzzle:



## Chain 9 with Bridal white

 color yarn.Round 1: 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 6 sc , 4 sc in the last stitch, continue
on the bottom with $6 \mathrm{sc}, 2$
sc in the last stitch. (20)
Round 2: 1 sc , inc, 7 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 7 sc , inc. (24)
Round 3: 2 sc , inc, 7 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc, 7 sc , inc, 1 sc . (28)
Round 4: 28 sc. (28)
Round 5: inc, 1 sc, inc, 11
sc, inc, 1 sc , inc, 11 sc . (32)

Round 6: (1 sc, inc) $\times 3$ times, 9 sc , (inc, 1 sc ) $\times 3$ times, inc, 9 sc, inc. (40)
Round 7-8: 40 sc . (40)
Fasten of with a sl st and leave a long tail. Sew the muzzle between round 35 and 48 (just under the eyes) on the head. Stuff the muzzle firmly while sewing.

## Nose:

Chain 9 with Light navy color yarn.
Round 1: 1 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 7 sc. (8)
Round 2: Chain1 to turn, dec, 4 sc , dec. (6)
Round 3: Chain1 to turn, dec, 2 sc , dec. (4)
Round 4: Chain1 to turn, dec $x 2$ times. (2)
Round 5: Chain1 to turn, crochet single crochets around, fasten off and leave a long tail. Sew the nose on the muzzle between round 1 and 5 . Stuff the nose a little while sewing. Hide the thread in the muzzle.
Embroider a stripe as snout with English tea color yarn.

## Ears (2x):

Chain 9 with English tea color yarn.
Round 1: 1 sc in the second stitch from the hook, $6 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. Continue at the bottom with $6 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (20)
Round 2: 20 sc . (20)
Round 3: 1 sc , inc, 7 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 7 sc ,inc.(24)
Round 4: 1 sc , inc, 9 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 9 sc ,inc.(28)
Round 5: 28 sc . (28)
Round 6: 1 sc , dec, $9 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$, dec, 9 sc , dec. (24)

Round 7: 24 sc. (24)
Round 8: 1 sc , dec, $7 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$, dec, 7 sc , dec. (20)

Round 9: 20 sc . (20)
Round 10: 1 sc , dec, 5 sc , dec, 1 sc , dec, 5 sc , dec. (16)
Round 11: 16 sc . (16)
Round 12: 1 sc , dec, 3 sc , dec, 1 sc , dec, 3 sc , dec. (12)
Round 13-14: 12 sc . (12)
Round 15: dec x 6 times. (6)
Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the 6 front loops and pull tightly. Insert the thread inside towards round 1, so you can use the thread for sewing.
Sew the ears on the head between round 59 and 63.

## Feet (2x):

Chain 5 with Bridal white color yarn.
Round 1: 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch, continue on the bottom with $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (12) Round 2: 1 sc , inc $\times 2$ times, 1 sc , inc $\times 2$ times, 1 sc, inc $x 2$ times, 1 sc, inc $x 2$ times. (20)

Round 3: 1 sc , inc, 7 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 7 sc, inc. (24)
Round 4: 1 sc , inc, $9 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}, 1$
sc, inc, 9 sc, inc. (28)
Round 5: 28 sc . (28)
Round 6: inc, 1 sc , inc, 11 sc ,
inc, 1 sc, inc, 11 sc. (32)
Round 7: 32 sc . (32)
Round 8: (1 sc, inc) x 2 times, 13
sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 12 sc. (36)
Round 9: 36 sc . (36)
Round 10: 2 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 15 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 13 sc . (40)
Round 11: 40 sc. (40)
Round 12: 3 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 17 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 14 sc . (44)
Round 13-19: 44 sc . (44)
Round 20: 6 sc , dec, 1 sc , dec, 17 sc , dec, 1 sc , dec, 11 sc. (40)
Round 21: 40 sc . (40)
Round 22: 5 sc , dec, $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 15 \mathrm{sc}$, dec, 1 sc , dec, 10 sc. (36)
Round 23: 1 sc , (dec, 1 sc ) $\times 3$ times, dec, 7 sc , (dec, 1 sc ) $\times 3$ times, dec, 6 sc . (28)
Round 24: (dec, 1 sc ) x 3 times, dec, 3 sc , (dec, 1
sc) $x 3$ times, dec, 3 sc . (20) Stuff the foot a little.
Round 25: ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) x 2 times, 5 sc , dec, 1 sc , dec, 4 sc. (16)
Round 26: 16 sc. (16)
Round 27: dec, 1 sc , dec, 3 sc , dec, 1 sc , dec, 3 sc. (12) Stuff the foot a little more.
Round 28: dec $x 6$ times. (6)
Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the 6 front loops and pull tightly. Insert the thread inside towards round 3, so you can use this thread for sewing.
Embroider with English tea color yarn toes on the foot, sew the thread between round 18 and 23 and pull firmly.

## Sole of the foot 2x:

Chain 5 with Light navy color yarn.
Round 1: 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch, continue on the bottom with $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (12)
Round 2: 1 sc , (inc) $x 2$ times, 1 sc , (inc) $\times 2$ times, 1 sc , (inc) $\times 2$ times, 1 sc , (inc) $\times 2$ times. (20)

Round 3: 1 sc , inc, 7 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 7 HST, inc. (24)

Round 4: Chain1 to turn, crochet single crochets around.
Fasten of with a sl st and leave a long tail. Sew the sole on the foot between round 5 and 11.

## Foot cushions:

## Small 2x for each foot:

6 sc in a magic ring with Light navy color yarn. Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail.

## Large 1 x for each foot:

6 sc in a magic ring with Light navy color yarn.
( 2 x inc, 1 sc ) $\times 2$ times. (10)
Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail.
Sew the foot cushions on the foot, according to the picture above.

FIRST sew the front legs onto the body, and then the back legs.

## Front legs 2x:

Chain 5 with Bridal white color yarn.
Round 1: 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch, continue on the bottom with $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (12)
Round 2: 1 sc , inc $\times 2$ times, 1 sc , inc $\times 2$ times, 1 sc, inc $\times 2$ times, 1 sc , inc $\times 2$ times. (20)
Round 3: 20 sc . (20)
Round 4: 1 sc , inc $\times 2$ times, 5 sc , inc $\times 2$ times, 10 sc. (24)
Round 5: 2 sc , inc $\times 2$ times, 7 sc , inc $\times 2$ times, 11 sc . (28)
Round 6-7: 28 sc. (28)
Round 8: 3 sc , dec $\times 2$ times, 7 sc , dec $\times 2$ times, 10 sc. (24)
Round 9: 3 sc , dec $\times 2$ times, 3 sc , dec $\times 2$ times, 10 sc. (20)
Round 10: 1 sc, dec $\times 2$ times, 4 sc , dec $\times 2$
times, 7 sc. (16) Change in the last sc to English tea yarn.
Round 11-20: 16 sc. (16)
Round 21: Crochet 4 sc more. Stuff the leg firmly.
Close the leg with 8 sc through both sides together. Fasten off and leave a long tail. Embroider with Light navy yarn toes (see picture) on the front legs, between round 9 on the front side and round 9 on the back side. Pull the thread firmly and fasten off. Hide the thread in the leg.

Sew the front legs on the body on round 23 of the body.
Sew the hind legs (feet) on the body between round 8 and 20 of the body.

## Band:

Chain 5 with Bridal white color yarn.
Round 1: 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch, continue on the bottom with 2 sc , 2 sc in the last stitch. (12) Round 2: 1 sc , inc $\times 2$ times, 1 sc, inc $\times 2$ times, 1 sc , inc x 2 times, 1 sc , inc $x 2$ times. (20)
Round 3: 1 sc , inc, 7 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 7 sc , inc. (24)



Round 4: inc, 1 sc , inc, 9 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 9 sc . (28)

Round 5: 1 sc , inc, $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}, 11 \mathrm{sc}$, inc, 1 sc , inc, 10 sc . (32)
Round 6: 2 sc , inc, $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}, 13 \mathrm{sc}$, inc, 1 sc , inc, 11 sc. (36)
Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Sew the band just on the front legs between round 22 and 33 .

## Tail:

6 sc in a magic ring with Bridal white color yarn.
Round 1: (inc, 2 sc ) $x 2$ times. (8)
Round 2: 1v, inc, 3 sc , inc, 2 sc . (10)
Round 3: 1 sc , inc, $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$, inc, 1 sc , inc, 1 sc. (14)
Round 4-6: 14 sc . (14) Change in the last sc of round 6 to English tea yarn.
Round 7-21: 14 sc . (14)
Round 22: 4 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 4 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc. (18)

Stuff the tail lightly and crochet together with 9 sc. Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Sew the tail diagonally on the body between round 7 and 13.

## Collar:

Chain about 45 with Light navy color yarn. Attention: The number of stitches may differ per puppy!
Regularly check whether the number of stitches is already correct.
1 sc in the second stitch from the hook, (about) $42 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch, continue at the bottom with (about) 43 sc . (88)
Put the dog collar around Spike's neck and sew the collar together with a few stitches. Fasten off the threads.
Decorate the collar with a charm if you want to.
