## Crochet pattern Sofie

## Materials needed:

Do you want to chrochet Sofie?

Scheepjes catona :

| 388 | Rust | 25 | grams |
| 208 | Yellow gold | 10 | grams |
| 106 | Snow white | 75 | grams |

2 safety eyes 10 mm
Crochet hook 2.5 mm
Stuffing
Tapestry needle
Scissors
Marker

## Stitches used:

MR = Magic ring
Ch = Chain stitch
SI st = slip stitch
Sc = single crochet
Hdc = half double crochet
Dc = double crochet
Chain stitch to turn
Inc = increase
Dec = decrease

## How to crochet Sofie:

## The legs 4x :

Chain 5 with Topaz yarn.

1. 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch.
Continue at the
bottom with $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2$
sc in the last stitch. (12)
2. 1 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc. (16)
3. 2 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc, 1 sc . (20)
4. In the back loops only: 20 sc. (20)

5-6. 20 sc. (20)
7. $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$, dec, 1 sc. (16)
Change to Snow white yarn in the last single crochet.
8 -11. 16 sc. (16)
12. (inc, 3 sc ) $\times 4$ times. (20)
13. 20 sc . (20)
14. (dec, 3 sc ) $\times 4$ times. (16)
15-18.16 sc. (16)
Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail.
Crochet 3 more legs.
Stuff the legs lightly.

## Eye spot:

Chain 5 with Rust yarn.

1. 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch.
Continue at the bottom with $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (12)
2. 1 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc. (16) 3. 1 sc , inc, 5 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 5 sc , inc. (20) 4. inc, 1 sc , inc, 7 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 7 sc . (24)
3. 1 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, $4 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{hdc}$, inc, 1 sc , inc, 4 sc, 4 hdc. (28)

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail.
The eye spot is later sewn on the head.

## The body and the head:

Chain 21 with Snow white yarn.

1. 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, $18 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch.
Continue at the bottom with $18 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last sc. (44)
2. 1 sc , inc, 19 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 19 sc , inc. (48)
3. (1 sc, inc) $\times 2$ times, 17 sc , (inc, 1 sc$) \times 3$ times, inc, 17 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc. (56)
4. inc, 1 sc , inc, 25 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 25 sc . (60)
5. inc, 3 sc , inc, now work the first leg onto the body with 7 sc , work through both parts! First with the crochet hook through the leg, then through the body. The leg is on the body, so to speak. (Make sure that the leg is straight!) 11 hdc , now crochet the second leg onto the body with 7 sc , inc, 3 sc, inc, now crochet the third leg onto the body with 7 sc, 11 hdc, now crochet the fourth leg onto
 the body with 7
sc. (64)
6. $7 \mathrm{sc}, 9 \mathrm{sc}$ from the leg, $11 \mathrm{hdc}, 9 \mathrm{sc}$ from the leg, $7 \mathrm{sc}, 9 \mathrm{sc}$ from the leg, $11 \mathrm{hdc}, 9$ sc on the leg. (72)
7. 28 sc , inc, 6 sc, inc, 8 sc, inc, 6 sc, inc, 20 sc. (76)
8. 76 sc. (76)

Stuff the legs firmly.
9. 30 sc , inc, 6 sc , inc, 8 sc , inc, 6 sc , inc, 22 sc. (80)
10. 72 sc , skip the last 8 sc of this round. (80)
11. Chain 24 , skip 24 sc ( 8 sc of round 10 and 16 sc of round 11) and continue with 56 sc , the last 8 sc of round 11 (so sc 57 to 64)you make on round 9. (80) DO NOT use the chain for crocheting. Push the chain in the body.
12. Now crochet all 80 sc . (80)
13. 80 sc . (80)
14. $30 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 6 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 12 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 6 \mathrm{sc}$, dec,

18 sc. (76)
15. 76 sc . (76)
16. $30 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 6 \mathrm{sc}$, dec, 8 sc , dec, 6 sc , dec, 12 sc, skip the last 6 sc. (72)
17. Chain 24 , skip 24 sc ( 6 sc of round 16 and 18 sc of round 17) and continue with 11 sc , dec, 4 sc , dec, 11 sc , dec, 4 sc , dec, 10 sc , the last 6 sc of round 17 (so sc 45 to 50 ) you make on round 16. (68)
DO NOT use the chain for crocheting. Push the chain in the body.
18. $16 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 10 \mathrm{sc}$, (dec, 1 sc ) $\times 2$ times, dec, 8 sc , (dec, 1 sc ) x 2 times, dec, 10 sc , $\mathrm{dec}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$. (60)
19. 28 sc , dec $\times 8$ times, 16 sc . (52) Stuff the body.
20. 2 sc , dec, 4 sc , dec, 16 sc , dec, 1 sc , dec, 2 $\mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$, dec, 14 sc . (46)
21. 1 sc , dec, 4 sc , dec, 5 sc , dec, 9 sc , dec, 4 sc, dec, 9 sc , dec, 2 sc. (40)
22. $17 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec} \times 8$ times, 7 sc . (32)
23. $19 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$, dec, 8 sc . (30)
24. 17 sc , dec $\times 4$ times, 5 sc . (26)
25. 15 sc , dec $\times 4$ times, 3 sc . (22)
26. inc, 10 sc , inc, 10 sc . (24)
27. 24 sc. (24)
28. inc, 1 sc , inc, 9 sc, inc, 1 sc , inc, 9 sc. (28)
29. 1 sc , (inc, 1 sc ) $\times 2$ times, inc, 7 sc , (inc, 1 sc) $x 3$ times, inc, 7 sc , inc. (36)
30. 2 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 15 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 13 sc. (40)
Stuff the body a bit more.
31. 2 sc , (inc, 1 sc ) $\times 3$ times, inc, 13 sc , (inc, 1 sc) $x 3$ times, inc, 11 sc. (48)
32-33.48 sc. (48)
34. 6 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 21 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 15 sc. (52)
35-42.52 sc. (52)
43. $8 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$, dec,
$21 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$, dec, 13 sc. (48)
44. $4 \mathrm{sc},(\mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}) \times 3$ times, dec, 13 sc , (dec, 1 sc) x 3 times, dec, 9 sc. (40)
45. 40 sc. (40)
46. $6 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$, $15 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$, dec, 9 sc. (36)
47. 36 sc. (36)
48. Place the eye spot under Sofie's left
eye. The left eye is between row 3 and
4 of the eye spot. Place the eyes in the head between round 40 and 41 with 7 sc in between.
Don't sew the eye spot yet, this will come after sewing on the muzzle.
3 sc , (dec, 1 sc ) $\times 3$ times, dec, 7 sc , (dec, 1 sc) $\times 3$ times, dec, 4 sc. (28)
49. 1 sc , (dec, 1 sc ) $\times 3$ times, dec, 3 sc , (dec, 1 sc) $\times 3$ times, dec, 2 sc. (20)
50. dec $x 4$ times, 4 sc, dec $\times 4$ times. (12)

Stuff the head.
51. dec $\times 6$ times.
(6)

Fasten off with a sl st and
leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the 6 front loops and pull tightly, hide the thread in the head.


## Muzzle:

1. 6 sc in a MR with Apricot yarn. (6)
2. inc $\times 6$ times. (12)
3. inc, 1 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 3 sc . (16)
4. (1 sc, inc) x 8 times. (24)
5. 2 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, $9 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$, inc, 7 sc . (28)
6. 1 sc , (inc, 1 sc ) $\times 3$ times, inc, 7 sc , (inc, 1 sc) $x 3$ times, inc, 6 sc. (36)
7. 36 sc. (36)
8. 6 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 15 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 9 sc . (40)
9. 40 sc . (40)
10. $6 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 15 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 9$ sc. (36)
Change to Snow white yarn in the last sc.
$11-13.36$ sc. (36)
11. 7 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 15 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 8 sc. (40)
Fasten off with a sl st
and leave a long tail.
Stuff the muzzle
lightly and stuff more while sewing.
Sew the muzzle on the
 head between round
27 and 40 (just below
the eyes).
Afterwards sew the eye spot on the head. The eye spot is slightly on the muzzle.

## Nostrils 2x:

Chain 5 with Apricot yarn.

1. 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 2 $\mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (6)
Fasten off with a sl st in the first made sc of this row (the nostril will be already a bit round, which is handy with sewing) and leave a long tail.
Sew the nostrils on the muzzle between round 6 and 8 with 8 sc in between.

## Eyebrow:

Embroider an eyebrow with
Rust yarn, according to the picture. The highest point of the eyebrow is 3 rows above the eyes.

## Ears 2x:

Make 1 ear with Rust yarn and 1 ear with Snow white yarn.
Chain 7.

1. 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 4 $\mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch.
Continue at the bottom with $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last sc. (16)
2. 16 sc . (16)
3. 1 sc , inc, 5 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 5 sc , inc. (20)

4-5. 20 sc. (20)
6. 1 sc , dec, $5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$, dec, $5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$. (16)
7. $\quad 16 \mathrm{sc}$. (16)
8. 1 sc , dec, $3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$, dec, 3 sc , dec. (12)
9. $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$, dec.
(8)
10. dec $\times 4$ times. (4)

The ears are not stuffed.
Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Pull the thread through the 4 front loops and
pull tightly. Insert the thread inside the ear
towards round 1 (you can use the thread for sewing) and with 2 stitches sew the ear almost double. Sew the ear to the side of the head between round 40 and 44 .

## Ear tag:

Chain 4 with Yellow gold yarn.

1. 1 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 2 sc. (3)
2. chain 1 to turn, turn, 3 sc . (3)
3. chain 1 to turn, turn, 3 sc . (3)
4. chain 1 to turn, turn, 1 sl st, 1 sl st, chain $4,1 \mathrm{sl}$ st in the same sl st, 1 sl st.
Fasten off, use the thread to sew the tag at the ear. Fasten off the threads and hide them in the tag or the ear.

## Horns 2x:

1. 4 sc in a MR with Topaz yarn. (4)
2. inc $x 4$ times. (8)
3. 8 sc . (8)
4. inc $\times 2$ times, 2 sc, inc $\times 2$ times, 2 sc. (12)

5-7. 12 sc. (12)
Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail.


Stuff the horns lightly.
Sew the horns on the top of the head.

## Tail:

1. 4 sc in a MR with Snow white yarn. (4)
2. inc $x 4$ times. (8)

3-8. 8 sc. (8)
Fasten of with a sl st and leave a long tail. First insert the thread in the middle back and forth, so it will be easier to knot the threads, and then inside towards round 1. Use the thread as sewing thread.
The tail doesn't need to be stuffed.
With Rust yarn make a bunch of threads at the tail and tie it. Pull the threads a

little apart with a pin so that the tail becomes a little fluffy. If necessary, trim the tail neatly.

## Udder:

Chain 5 with Apricot yarn.

1. 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 2 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch.
Continue at the bottom with $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (12)
2. 1 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc. (16)
3. 1 sc , inc, 5 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 5 sc , inc. (20)
4. 20 sc . (20)

Fasten of with a sl st and leave a long tail.
Sew the udder just before/between the hind legs and stuff while sewing.

## Teats:

1. 4 sc in a MR with Apricot yarn. (4)
2-3. 4 sc. (4)
Fasten of with a sl st and leave a long tail, sew the teats on the udder.

## Spots:

## Big spot:

Chain 5 with Rust yarn.

1. 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 2 sc, inc. (6)
2. chain 1 to turn, turn, 6 sc . (6)
3. chain 1 to turn, turn, inc, 5 sc. (7)
4. chain 1 to turn, turn, 6 sc , inc. (8)
5. chain 1 to turn, turn, inc $\times 2$ times, 4 sc , inc $x 2$ times. (12)
6. chain 1 to turn, turn, 12 sc . (12)
7. chain 1 to turn, turn, inc $\times 2$ times, 8 sc , inc $x 2$ times. (16)
8-9. chain 1 to turn, turn, 16 sc . (16)
8. chain 1 to turn, turn, dec $\times 2$ times, 10 sc , dec. (13)
9. chain 1 to turn, turn, dec, $7 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec} \times 2$ times. (10)
10. chain 1 to turn, turn, 10 sc . (10)
11. chain 1 to turn, turn, dec $\times 2$ times, 2 sc, dec $\times 2$ times. (6)
12. chain 1 to turn, turn,


6 sc. (6)
15. chain 1 to turn, turn, dec $\times 2$ times, 2 sc . (4)

16-17.chain 1 to turn, turn, 4 sc . (4)
18. chain 1 to turn, turn, dec $\times 2$ times. (2)

Chain 1 to turn and crochet all around with single crochets.
Fasten of with a sl st and leave a long tail. Sew the spot on Sofie's back(side).

## Spot on Sophie's buttock:

1. 4 sc in a MR with Rust yarn.
2. inc $x 4$ times. (8)
3. (inc, 1 sc$) \times 4$ times. (12)
4. inc, 1 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 3 sc . (16) Fasten of with a sl st and leave a long tail. Sew the spot on Sofie's buttock.

## Spot on the back of the head:

4 sc in a MR with Rust yarn.
2. inc $x 4$ times. (8)
3. (inc, 1 sc ) $\times 4$ times. (12)

Fasten of with a sl st and
 leave a long tail.
Sew the spot on the back of the head.

## Small spot on the breast:

Chain 6 with Rust yarn.

1. 1 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 4 sc. (5)
2. chain 1 to turn, turn, inc, 4 sc . (6)
3. chain 1 to turn, turn, 4 sc , (inc) $\times 2$ times. (8)
4. chain 1 to turn, turn, (inc) $\times 2$ times, 4 sc , dec. (9)
5. chain 1 to turn, turn, dec, $3 \mathrm{sc},(\mathrm{dec}) \times 2$ times. (7)
6. chain 1 to turn, turn, dec, 2 sc , dec. (4) Chain 1 to turn, turn and crochet all around with single crochets, make 2 sc in the sc at each corner.
Fasten off with a sl st and leave e long tail.
Sew the spot on Sofie's breast.

## Bell:

Chain 5 with Yellow gold yarn.

1. 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 2 $\mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch.
Continue at the bottom with $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the last stitch. (12)
2-3. 12 sc . (12)
2. inc, 1 sc , inc, 3 sc , inc, 1 sc , inc, 3 sc . (16)
3. 16 sc . (16)
4. In back loops only: 16 sc. (16)

Stuff the bell a little.
7. Through both loops: dec $\times 8$ times. (8) Fasten off, pull the thread through the 8 front loops and pull tightly. Insert the thread inside towards round 1, make a small loop and a sl st, chain 6, sl st and attach the loop to the bell.
Fasten off and hide the thread in the bell.

## Strap for the bell:

Chain 50 with Topaz yarn.
1 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 48 sc. (49)
Fasten off with a sl st, hang the bell on the strap. Put the strap around Sofie's neck and sew the ends together.
Sew the strap around the neck with a few stitches.
