MR	Magic ring
Ch	Chain
Sl st	Slip stitch
Sc	Single crochet
HDC	Half Double Crochet
DC	Double Crochet
Incr	Increase
Decr	Decrease

Pattern is written in VS terms.

*The names of the cotton colors are named in the pattern.

4 safety eyes 7mm
Crochet hook 2.5 mm
Piece of a place mat or something similar
Optionally a music box
Polyester stuffing
tapestry needle
Scissors
Marker



How to crochet the farm:

Chain 21 with Rust color yarn.

Round 1: 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 18 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch. Continue at the bottom with 18 sc, 2 sc in the last stitch. (44)

Round 2: 1 sc, inc, 19 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 19 sc, inc. (48)

Round 3: (inc, 1 sc) x2 times, inc, 17 sc, (inc, 1 sc) x3 times, inc, 17 sc, inc, 1 sc. (56)

Round 4: (1 sc, inc) x2 times, 25 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 24 sc. (60)

Round 5: (inc, 1 sc) x3 times, inc, 23 sc, (inc, 1 sc) x3 times, inc, 23 sc. (68)

Round 6: (inc, 1 sc) x5 times, inc, 23 sc, (inc, 1 sc) x5 times, inc, 23 sc. (80)

Round 7: 2 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 7 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 27 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 7 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 25 sc. (88)

Round 8: 3 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 9 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 29 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 9 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 26 sc. (96)

Round 9: 5 sc, inc, 13 sc, inc, 33 sc, inc, 13 sc, inc, 28 sc. (100)

Round 10: Crochet in the back loops only 100 sc. (100)

Round 11: Continue to crochet in both loops: 5 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 33 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 28 sc. (96)

Lay the piece on a place mat and draw around with a pen. Cut out the shape of the bottom and place it on your piece of cloth. This is to flatten the bottom so that the farm will stand better. Make sure the bottom falls just inside the back loops, you will use these loops to crochet on the grass.

Round 12: 96 sc. (96)

ATTENTION! From now on you crochet in rows and turn your work at the end of each row! The even rows start on the outside, the odd rows start at the inside.

Row 13-35: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 96 sc. (96)

Row 36: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 5 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 31 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 26 sc. (92)

Row 37: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 92 sc. (92)

Row 38: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 4 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 29 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 25 sc. (88)

Row 39: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 88 sc. (88)

Row 40: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 3 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 27 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 24 sc. (84)

Row 41: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 84 sc. (84)

Row 42: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 2 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 25 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 23 sc. (80)

Row 43: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 80 sc. (80)

Row 44: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 1 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 23 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 22 sc. (76)

Row 45: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 76 sc. (76)



Row 46: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, dec, 13 sc, dec, 21 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 21 sc. (72)

Crochet 1 sc more, this is where the new row starts! (move your marker)

Row 47: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 72 sc. (72)

Row 48: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 13 sc, dec, 19 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 19 sc, dec. (68)

Row 49: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 68 sc. (68)

If you use a music box, place it now.

- turn the rewind lever to the left, then it will loosen.

- insert the metal rod through you crocheted work at approximately row 19/20.

- tighten the rewind lever again, make sure that no stitches get caught in the lever.

If you don't use a music box, you can put some plastic pellets on the bottom.

Stuff the farm in half.

Row 50: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 13 sc, dec, 17 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 17 sc, dec. (64)

Row 51: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 64 sc. (64)

Row 52: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 13 sc, dec x2 times, 11 sc, dec x2 times, 13 sc, dec x2 times, 11 sc, dec x2 times. (56)

Row 53: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 56 sc. (56)

Row 54: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 13 sc, dec x2 times, 7 sc, dec x2 times, 13 sc, dec x2 times, 7 sc, dec x2. (48)

Row 55: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 48 sc. (48)

Row 56: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 13 sc, dec, 7 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 7 sc, dec. (44)

Row 57: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 44 sc. (44)

Row 58: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 13 sc, dec, 5 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 5 sc, dec. (40)

Row 59: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 40 sc. (40)

Row 60: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 13 sc, dec, 3 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 3 sc, dec. (36)

Row 61: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 36 sc. (36)

Row 62: 1 sl st, chain 1 to turn, turn, 13 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec. (32)

Stuff the farm firmly.

Row 63: Fold up the roof of the farm and crochet both parts together with 16 sc, fasten off, leave a long tail and weave the thread into the farm.

The roof of the farm:

Chain 57 with Metal grey color yarn.

Row 1: 1 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 55 sc. (56)

Row 2-13: Chain 1 to turn, 56 sc. (56)

Row 14: Crochet single crochets all the way around with, in every corner make 2 sc.

Start with 1 chain, 12 sc, 2 sc in the corner, 55 sc, 2 sc in the corner, 12 sc, 2 sc in the corner, 55 sc, 2 sc in the corner, change color to white in the last sc. (142)

Row 15: Crochet in the back loops only: 13 sc (you are now in the first sc of the 2 sc on the corner), 26 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 26 sc, 14 sc,

26 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 26 sc, 1 sc. (138)
Row 16: Crochet in both loops: 13sc, 25 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 25 sc, 14sc, 25 sc, dec, 1sc, dec, 25 sc, 1 sc.
 Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail (about 1 meter). Sew the roof on the farm.

The entrance to the stable:

Chain 23 with Metal grey color yarn.
Row 1: 1 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 21 sc. (22)
Row 2-12: Chain 1 to turn, 22 sc. (22)
Row 13: Chain 1 and crochet single crochets around, in every corner crochet 1 chain extra, in this way the corners become a bit nicer in shape. Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Sew the entrance to the stable in between row 21 and 35 on the farm. Weave the thread into the farm.

The window frames of the entrance to the stable:

Side frames 2x:

Chain 23 with Snow white color yarn.
Row 1: 1 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 20 sc, 2 sc in the last stitch, continue at the bottom with 21 sc.
 Fasten off, leave a long tail and sew side frames with one side on the last row of the entrance, and the other side on the farm.
 Fasten off and weave the thread into the farm.

Top frame:

Chain 33 with Snow white color yarn.
Row 1: 1 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 31 sc. (32)
Row 2-3: Chain 1 to turn, 32 sc. (32)
 Fasten off and leave a long tail. Sew the top frame just over the entrance to the stable and just over the sides. Sew the top frame slightly bent.

The stable door:

Chain 13 with English tea color yarn.
Row 1: 1 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 11 sc. (12)
Row 2-3: Chain 1 to turn, turn, 12 sc, change color to Hazelnut in the last sc of row 3. (12)
Row 4: Chain 1 to turn, turn, 12 sc in the back loops only, change color to English tea color in the last sc. (12)
Row 5: Chain 1 to turn, turn, 12 sc in the back loops only. (12)
Row 6-7: Chain 1 to turn, turn, 12 sc, change color to Hazelnut



in the last sc of row 7. (12)
Row 8: Chain 1 to turn, turn, 12 sc in the back loops only, change color to English tea color in the last sc. (12)
Row 9: Chain 1 to turn, turn, 12 sc in the back loops only. (12)
Row 10-11: Chain 1 to turn, turn, 12 sc, change color to Hazelnut in the last sc of row 11. (12)



Row 12: Chain 1 to turn, turn, 12 sc in the back loops only, change color to English tea in the last sc. (12)
Row 13: Chain 1 to turn, turn, 12 sc in the back loops only. (12)
Row 14-15: Chain 1 to turn, turn, 12 sc, change color to Hazelnut in the last sc of row 15. (12)
Row 16: Chain 1 to turn, turn, 12 sc in the back loops only, change color to English tea in the last sc. (12)
Row 17: Chain 1 to turn, turn, 12 sc in the back loops only. (12)
Row 18-19: Chain 1 to turn, turn, 12v, change color to Hazelnut in the last sc of row 19. (12)
Row 20: Chain 1 to turn, turn, 12 sc in the back loops only, change color to English tea in the last sc. (12)
Row 21: Chain 1 to turn, turn, 12 sc in the back loops only. (12)
Row 22-23: Chain 1 to turn, turn, 12 sc. (end up at the rear of your crochet work)
 Now first weave all the threads in the back of your crochet work before you start to crochet single crochets all around.
 Chain 1 to turn, turn, crochet sc with English tea yarn around the stable door, 2 sc in every corner. (Now you crochet at the front of your crochet work.)
 Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Sew the stable door over the entrance and the window frames of the stable. Fasten off and weave the thread in the farm.

Upper window:

Chain 9 with Metal grey color yarn.
Row 1: 1 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 7 sc. (8)
Row 2-4: Chain 1 to turn, turn, 8 sc. (8)
Row 5: Chain 1 to turn, turn, dec, 4 sc, dec. (6)
Row 6: Chain 1 to turn, turn, dec, 2 sc, dec. (4)
 Chain 1, crochet sc around.
 Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Sew the upper window 4 rows above the stable door.

Side frame upper window 2x:

Chain 9 with Snow white color yarn.
Row 1: 1 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 6 sc, 2 sc in the last sc, continue at the bottom with 8 sc. (17) Fasten off and leave a long tail.

Top frame:

Chain 15 with Snow white color yarn.

Row 1: 1 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 13 sc. (14)

Row 2: Chain 1 to turn, turn, 14 sc. (14)

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail.

Shelf with straw:

Chain 13 with Snow white color yarn.

Row 1: Chain 1 to turn, turn, 12 sc. (12)

Row 2: Chain 1 to turn, turn, inc, 10 sc, inc. (14)

Row 3: Chain 1 to turn, turn, 14 sc, change color to Yellow gold in the last sc.

Row 4: Chain 1 to turn, turn, 14 sc in the front loops only. (14)

Row 5: Now crochet the straw in the front loops of row 4 (the loops are white)

Crochet the straw as follows: chain 1 to turn, turn, * 1 sc, chain 6, crochet 5 sl st back, the next sl st in the front loop where you started, continue in the next loop*. Crochet again from * to * until you have done all 14 sc. Crochet another row in the front loops of row 4 only (yellow), where you have crocheted the front loops.

Crochet this row back with 1 sc, chain 4, 3 sl st. Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail.

Grass:

Round 1: Crochet around row 10 with Kiwi yarn in the front loops only.

Start sc at the left side of the barn door, left side, back side right side, barn door. (100)

Round 2: Crochet another round sc around the barn. Start again at the left side of the barn door, left side, back side, right side, and end on the right side of the barn door.

(The barn door will only be crocheted 1 round) During this second round chain 13 at the sides of the barn left and right for the stalk of the sunflower, turn, 12 sc, 1 sl st in the first sc. (see picture of the back side of the barn) At the back side of the barn crochet 3x a stalk for the sunflower.

1x a stalk: chain 15, turn, 14 sl st, continue crocheting the grass in the next sc.

1x a stalk: chain 21, turn, 20 sl st, continue crocheting the grass in the next sc.

1x a stalk: chain 15, turn, 14 sl st, continue crocheting the grass in the next sc.

The position and the number of single crochets between the stalks does not matter, you can do this at your own discretion.

Note that if you have the music box in the farm, you must take the wind-up lever into account.

If you like it, you can also decorate the grass with little blades of grass between the stalks of the sunflower by crocheting here and there 6 chains, turn and 5 sc back.



My version on the picture is as follows: 100 sc (round 1), blade of grass, 7 sc, stalk of the flower, 8 sc, blade of grass, 6 sc, stalk of the flower, 11 sc, stalk of the flower, 6 sc, stalk of the flower, 5 sc, blade of grass, 3 sc, blade of grass, 5 sc, stalk of the flower, 8 sc, blade of grass, 3 sc, (now you are at the right side of the barn door)

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail.

Sew the grass and the sunflowers on the farm.

Sun flower 5x:

For the heart of the flower:

6 sc in a magic ring with Hazelnut color yarn. Fasten off with a sl st in the first sc and leave a long tail.

For the sunflower:

5 sc in a magic ring with Yellow gold color yarn.

Round 1: Inc x 5 times. (10)

Round 2: 1 sc, * chain 4, turn, 3 sc, 1 sl st in the first sc, 1 sc in the next sc *, and repeat *until* 9 times (you now have a total of 10 petals on your flower)

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail.

Sew the hearts of the sunflower on the sunflowers and sew the sunflowers.

Sew the sunflowers onto the stalks. Fasten off and weave the thread in the farm.

For the leaves of the sunflower:

4 sc in a magic ring with kiwi yarn.

Round 1: Inc x 4 times. (8)

Round 2: Inc x 2 times, 2 sc, inc x 2 times, 2 scv. (12)

Round 3: Fold the leaf in half and close it with 1 sc.

Make 1 or 2 leaves for each flower.

Weave the thread in the leaf.

Sew the leaf on the side of the stalk of the sunflower.

Little goat:

First make the 2 eye spots of the goat

4 sc in a magic ring with Hazelnut color yarn.

Round 1: Inc x 4 times. (8)

Round 2: Inc x 2 times, 2 sc, inc x 2 times, 2 sc. (12)



Round 3: 1 sc, inc x 2 times, 4 sc, inc x 2 times, 3 sc. (16)

Round 4: 2 sc, (inc, 1 sc) x 4 times, 6 sc. (20)

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail.



Head:

Chain 5 with Snow white color yarn.

Round 1: 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 2 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch, continue at the bottom with 2 sc, 2 sc in the last stitch. (12)

Round 2: 12 sc. (12)

Round 3: 1 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc. (16)

Round 4: 16 sc. (16)

Round 5: inc, 1 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 5 sc. (20)

Round 6-8: 20 sc. (20)

Round 9: 2 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 7 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 5 sc. (24)

Round 10: 24 sc. (24)

Round 11: 3 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 9 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 6 sc. (28)

Round 12: 28 sc. (28)

Round 13: 4 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 9 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 5 sc. (24)

Round 14: 3 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 7 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 4 sc. (20)

Round 15: 2 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 5 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 3 sc. (16)

Place the eyes between row 3 and 4 of the eye spots, 1 sc next to the fasten off (see picture). Push the eyes through both parts between rows 10 and 11 with 4 sc between them.

Stuff a part of the head.

Round 16: 16 sc. (16)

Round 17: 1 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 3 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 2 sc. (12)

Round 18: Dec x 6 times. (6)

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. This thread you will use later to sew the head on the stable.

Ear of the goat 2x:

Round 1: 4 sc in a magic ring with Snow white color yarn.

Round 2: Inc x 4 times. (8)

Round 3: Inc x 2 times, 2 sc, inc x 2 times, 2 sc. (12)

Round 4: 12 sc. (12)

Round 5: Crochet 3 sc more, fold the ear in half and close it with 1 sc. Fasten off and leave a long tail. Sew the ears just above the spots on the head.

Horns of the goat 2x:

Round 1: 4 sc in a magic ring with Metal grey color yarn.

Round 2-3: 4 scv. (4)

Round 4: Inc, 1 sc, inc, 1 sc. (6)

Round 5-7: 6 sc. (6)

Fasten off with a sl st and leave a long tail. Stuff the horns a little bit and sew them at round 17 on the front of the head. Fasten off and weave the threads in the head.

Little Sheep:

Chain 5 with Snow white color yarn.

Round 1: 2 sc in the second stitch from the hook, 2 sc, 4 sc in the last stitch, continue at the bottom with 2 sc, 2 sc in the last stitch. (12)

Round 2: 12 sc. (12)

Round 3: 1 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc. (16)

Round 4: 16 sc. (16)

Round 5: Inc, 1 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 5 sc. (20)

Round 6-8: 20 sc. (20)

Round 9: 2 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 7 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 5 sc. (24)

Round 10: 3 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 9 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 6 sc. (28)

Round 11-12: 28 sc. (28)

Round 13: From now on crochet up to round 17 in the **back loops** only. 28 sc. (28) Place the eyes between round 8 and 9 with 3 sc in between.

Round 14: 4 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 9 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 5 sc. (24)

Round 15: 3 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 7 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 4 sc. (20)

Round 16: 2 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 5 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 3 sc. (16) Stuff a part of the head.

Round 17: 1 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 3 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, 2 sc. (12)

Fasten off with a sl st and pull the thread through the 12 front loops and pull on. Fasten off and weave the thread in your work.

Crochet with Scheepjes softy yarn the front loops that are visible on the head.

Sew the nose on the muzzle with Metal grey color yarn.

Ears of the sheep 2x:

Round 1: 4 sc in a magic ring with Snow white color yarn.

Round 2: Inc x 4 times. (8)

Round 3: Inc x 2 times, 2 sc, inc x 2 times, 2 sc. (12)

Round 4: 3 sc, inc x 2 times, 4 sc, inc x 2 times, 1 sc. (16)

Round 5: 16 sc. (16)

Fold the ear in half and close it with 1 sc.

Fasten off and leave a long tail.

Sew the ears on the head on tour 14.

Weave the starting thread (of your magic ring) in the ear.
